## How to Destroy Critical Race Theory (CRT) Fast

Parents should demand that every school board member, teacher union head, and classroom teacher answer the following questions and state why these questions are not addressed in CRT training?

- Critical Race Theory is just that a theory. What are the facts that support the theory?
- If whites are oppressors and blacks are victims, should they be segregated? If so, isn't this racist?
- If white racism is inescapable and black victimhood is inescapable, why even discuss these things?
- Some professors are saying we need to eliminate the white man. What would the world be today if there were never any white people?
- Native Americans, Asians, Latinos, Europeans, and Americans all made use of slaves. Slavery was not just racial, but *intra-racial* where one race bought and sold people of their own race. Didn't white men in Europe and the United States end slavery?
- All the races white, black, Asian, Mid-Eastern, Hispanic, etc. Why then are white people the only racists?
- The pirates along the Barbary Coast in North Africa raided ships in the Mediterranean and Atlantic and invaded towns on the shores kidnapping *white* men, women, and children. Across the Mediterranean, thousands of Christian slaves were taken and sold as slaves in Africa. Shouldn't Africans pay reparations to these white Europeans?
- But Africa today lags well beyond the rest of the world in terms of development and progress. Thirty-three of the 54 African countries ranks in the bottom quarter in the Human Development Index. Is this because Africans still practice slavery?
- Hispanics practiced black slavery well before whites. In fact, of the 12 million African slaves brought to the Western Hemisphere, less than 400,000 came to North America. Why are Hispanics not racist?
- Africans, Native Americans, Asians, Latinos, Europeans, and Americans all made use of slaves. Slavery infected every society, nationality, race, and religion. How come whites are the only racists?
- At one time nearly over 3,000 freed black men in America owned over 12,000 black slaves. Their treatment of these slaves was terrible. Were these black owners racist and shouldn't the ancestors of these slave-owners pay reparations to the ancestors of the slaves?

- The 1619 Project claims that American industry and prosperity were built on the backs of slaves. No, it was based on capitalism competition, ingenuity, and hard work. Capitalism occurred in the North while the South was stuck in farming. Slavery didn't build American industry; in many ways, it held it back. Had the U.S. followed a path of slavery, would it be as backward as most African nations, which rely on farming, menial work, and slavery?
- Baltimore schools rank third in spending per pupil. Yet in 13 of Baltimore's 39 high schools, not a single student scored proficient on the state's math exam. Is that because the teachers in Baltimore are so bad or that black students are constantly told under CRT that they are oppressed, and their condition will never change?
- The Ogbu study found African American kids readily admitted that they didn't work as hard as whites, it wasn't cool to do so, took easier classes, watched more TV, and read less. Is that because they are told that they don't have a chance in a white society or that to study hard would make African American kids "seem white"?
- Today blacks comprise 13 percent of the American population and 13 percent of them graduate from college. Blacks, however, underperform whites, Asians, and Latinos in the lower grades and high school. The NAACP blames racism for this problem. Why then do African Americans in Harvard and Vanderbilt perform comparably to whites and outperform whites in 21 other colleges?
- For the past 50 years, Democrats, both black and white officials, have run the largest 100 cities in the country. The real reason black youth underperform is that Democrat city leaders encourage African Americans to believe they are victims and oppressed just like CRT teaches. This victimhood treatment instills a sense of hopelessness in black youth and often leads to behavior that deviates from the norms of a society based on a nation of laws. Are these Democrat city leaders, like the teachers of CRT, doing nothing more than creating modern-day plantations?
- There are over 40 million slaves today, most of whom toil in Africa. Their slaves are not separated by race but by kinship. If the descendants of American slaves had stayed in Africa, would they be slaves today?
- African Americans as a group would rank in the top 45 countries of the world economically, higher than any African country. Are black people better off in a white society like the U.S. or a black society like Africa?
- If America is so racist and white supremacy exists in our society, why according to PEW Research, do 160 million non-white migrants want to relocate here?
